

Year 7 Catch Up Intervention Report 2017-18

Number of pupils who joined the school in Year 7 last year below the expected standard in reading was 32 (out of 141)

Number of pupils who joined the school in Year 7 last year below the expected standard in mathematics was 39 (out of 141).

Once pupils were identified we ensured that they were given targeted support via our literacy and numeracy programme. This included intervention as follows:

- Literacy co-ordinator working with all pupils below standard in small groups to bring about targeted improvement in reading.
- KS2 SATs papers sat in English and Maths to identify current gaps and help target English/Maths curriculum to bring about rapid and sustained improvement.
- Redesigned 'Anthology' literacy work – carried out during form time. Differentiated texts to ensure that all lower ability readers can access.
- Volunteers from UKC to be English/Maths mentors – working with targeted groups to help bring about an improvement in standards.
- Work with departments to ensure that there is cross-curricular work going on to bring about improvement.

Funding Allocation

We received £12,305 for catch up funding in 2017-18. The money was spent on the following:
